## KURA TRANSPORT

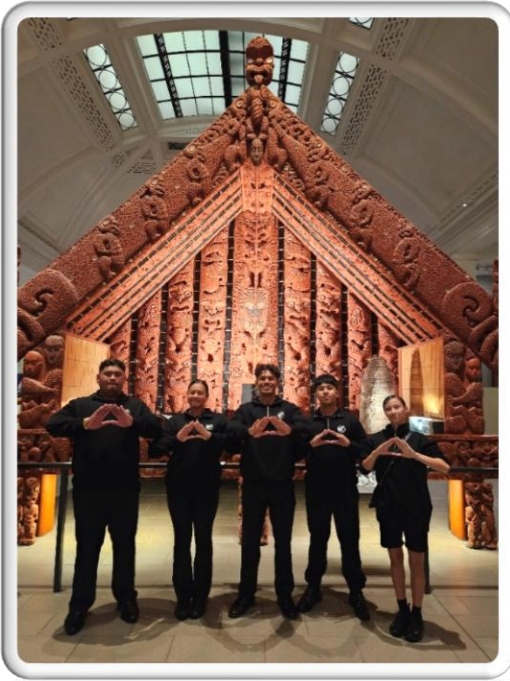
Hei kupu akiaki – a friendly dose of encouragement to remind our tamariki of the respect expected during their transport to kura via our two pahi ā-kura.

# TE KURA TEINA

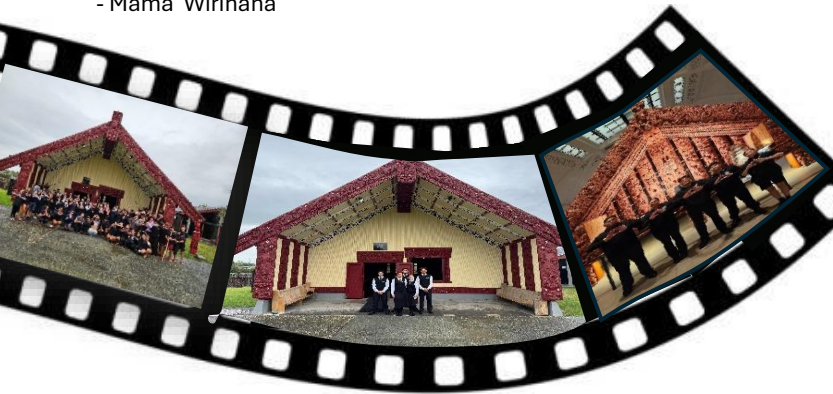

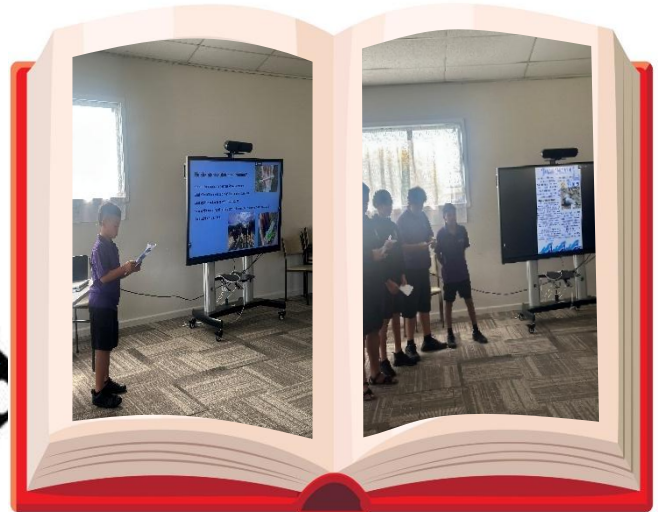
